

- Education, schedule dozens of workshops but no one shows up
- Langara: Sarah Bowers expanded from 1.5 to 5, full-time Internationalization Coordinator, UDL and student success module for all students, making recommendations to IT, scoping out tech tutors, Turnitin
- Emily Carr: Grant Gregson new campus, now reporting to VPAcademic, Learning Commons includes library, teaching and learning, sending faculty out to teaching and learning events, enhancement fund for adoption of pedagogy/ed tech, videos on indigenous craft, Kaltura demo, helping other departments, e.g. Press Books training for faculty handbook
- JIBC/BCTLN: Jennifer Jasper Centre for Leadership most of our folks are subject matter experts all online, challenging, e.g. conflict resolution going online, a lot of our staff are contract/sessional and want more support but often don't attend and fill workshops for example
- UVic: Janni Aragon training on privacy for staff and instructors, e.g. FIPPA
  rules, working on digital delivery of resources including an institutional plan,
  learning analytics with student affairs
- UNBC: Heather Smith 2.5 staff, Grant Potter sandstorm Wordpress, OER grant for student-involved project, university experiential learning grant carving of canoes, pit house, phase 2 of academic planning, chair 6 action groups indigenization, regional programming, learning outcomes, experiential learning several are engaging in benchmarking, change our online presence ie not just face-to-face or online must show synchronous and, annual conference T&L with 140 registrants where we highlight exemplars theme is Students as Partners and are thinking about students in governance
- RRU: Vivian Forssman Wordpress rollout starting in January and having several open courses as part of this; soon to initiate LMS evaluations; building program maps in Google sheets to identify scaffolding opportunities, teambased learning working at faculty level and with students including behavioural assessment, Facilitating Learning Online (FLO), running a Liberating Structures, Teaching with Technology grant showcase, Faculty Advisory Committee formed, base camp, accreditation, ASHOKA social innovation accreditation coming soon.
